- Event Location:** Along Angeles Forest Highway (Highway 59) in Angeles National Forest. Meet at Ralph's Supermarket parking lot in Sunland, CA (see Directions below).
- Event Directions:** To Ralph's Supermarket, 10455 Sunland Blvd, Sunland: From the 210 Freeway, take the Sunland Blvd exit and turn right (east) on Sunland Blvd. Ralph's Supermarket is on the left (north) side of the street.
- Events Planned:** Removal of all non-native shoots and plants that are growing along the road as a result of the spring rain.
- Event Description:** **Moderate to strenuous work**, removing non-native plants by hand and with pick axes. Tools will be provided.
