

“Station Fire” Update (as of August 27, 2009, 1:00 p.m.)

- **The “Station Fire” started at approximately 4:00 p.m. on August 26, 2009.**
- **The location is near Mile Marker 29 on Angeles Crest Highway in the Angeles National Forest (approximately 5 miles from LCF)**
- **Approximately 80 acres burned**
- **The fire has shift and is now burning to the northwest (i.e., away from the City)**
- **No structures burned or threatened**
- **Crews and air resources from the “Morris Fire” (Azusa area) have been deployed**
- **Additional LA County Fire resources are on alert**
- **Angeles Crest Highway will remain closed until further notice**
