

2020 Afternoon in the Park Guidelines

Please review the following guidelines to ensure a smooth and successful day

- Your 10' x 10' space will be assigned commensurate with your need based on availability
- The Chamber does **NOT** provide canopies, tables, chairs, decorations or signage but you are highly encouraged to!
- Vendor must supply any and all equipment, tables, tablecloths, decoration, and cashiering. You may want to bring giveaways!
- Electricity users must supply 50-ft orange extension cord for **EACH** item using power - along with an appropriate fire extinguisher
- Food vendors must comply with health code regulations, attach copy, and display- along with an appropriate fire extinguisher
- Area must be left clean and all debris removed or disposed of to receive refund. There will be garbage cans/dumpsters and recycling bins in the park area.
- Please do not drive your vehicles through the crowds of people. There is a dirt pathway at the top of the park that may be used for Food Vendors to access loading and unloading or designated loading zones on the street.
- If the Food Vendors Temporary Loading area is full when you are trying to unload, you may use the area on La Canada Blvd. Once again, this is a **TEMPORARY LOADING ZONE**.
- If you must deliver a huge piece of equipment, please do it between 7 -8 am or 10-11:30 am. It will be okay to drive on the lawn at that time and can be removed after 6:00pm when the event is over and the crowds have thinned out.
- No credits or refunds for booth space rental, cancellations, or no-shows.
