**USE OF FACE COVERINGS:** Please note that the County has not issued a requirement for the use of face coverings while engaging in exercise outdoors, solo walking, solo jogging, solo biking, trail use, etc. However, exercisers should keep a face covering with them when engaged in these activities in the event that they should come into contact with others.
